Take Stock in Children of Sarasota County, Inc. (TSIC) currently serves more than 250 middle and high school students in 22 schools in Sarasota County. Every student goes through an extensive application and interview process to be eligible for the program. All students must sign a contract agreeing to maintain good grades and stay crime and drug free. During their time in the program, a mentor is selected to meet with them for an hour each week. With a successful completion of the program, each child is awarded a full tuition scholarship through the Florida Prepaid College Foundation's Program STARS. This program matches every scholarship dollar raised in Sarasota County.
